



About the training

For working in open innovation from a problem- or mission-driven approach, a challenge trajectory is very well suited. This method helps in working on the same problem with multiple organizations. After all, many organizations have the same needs.

For this type of innovation programs, two main starting points are needed:

- It is important to start with a sharp, clear problem definition, with a solid business case.
- 2. The second point is that sufficient support base is created throughout the process up until the implementation. This is important for both the defined problem, as well as accepting solutions that come from external parties.

But where do you start? Where do you find parties with the same problem or mission? How do you prepare your organization? During this 2-day training we lead you through the steps to come to real solutions.

From defining the 'good' problem to the implementation of the solutions. This requires a structured approach and creating the right preconditions to organize a successful challenge.

As a spin-off from Holst Centre and neutral facilitator of large innovation challenge trajectories, we will gladly share our knowledge and experience in this training. We will give you tips and pointers on the do's and don'ts and the lessons learned.
